UNIT CHECK IN: Performers and seven (7) staff members will be admitted at guard check-in (see enclosed map for location). All guard members and staff must be wrist banded when checking in. Additional staff members or chaperones must purchase tickets from the ticket booth located at the front of the gymnasium. Units must check-in one (1) hour prior to their performance time. Check in will be open at _____

PARKING: Please review the enclosed map of the school for designated parking areas and equipment drop off.

DRESSING FACILITIES: The locker rooms located in the rear of the gymnasium will be open for the use of the performers for changing. Please vacate in a timely fashion to allow space for other guards. Lyman High School and the Florida Federation of Colorguards Circuit will not be responsible for lost, stolen or damaged property.

FOOTWEAR AND EQUIPMENT: All equipment tips of poles, sabers and rifles must be properly taped. Any props used must be protected to avoid damage to the gym area. Soft-soled shoes need not extra protection. Hard-soled shoes must be taped. All floor carts and rolling equipment or instruments must have clean working wheels. All equipment must also be removed from the gym immediately following your performance.

INSPECTIONS: Equipment and props will be inspected in the holding area prior to the performance. Questions regarding your equipment's legality will be determined by the Contest Director and Chief Judge assigned by the FFCC.

FLOOR SIZE: Contest floor will be 55' x 80'. We will also have another floor that will be down for additional protection throughout the day. If you are bringing your own floor, your floor will have to go over the floor provided.

TABULATING AND JUDGING AREA: Only authorized personnel will be allowed in the tabulating and judging area. DO NOT APPROACH THE TABULATION TABLE AT ANY TIME! You may pick up your judged tapes at the trophy table approximately 20 minutes after your unit's performance.

SHOW MUSIC: Music should be turned in to the sound table at least 30 minutes prior to the unit's performance time. The soundman will have music for units which competed at the color guard Premier shows.

SOUND CHECKS: Sound check will take place from ---- to ---- for percussion and from --- to --- for Colorguards. After this time, sound checks will only take place during official show breaks when the sound technician is available

WARM-UPS: There will be a body and equipment warm-up area. These areas are located on the north end of the campus in the performing arts building 8 and student union. We request that you adhere to the rotation schedule to help keep the show on time. There is also ample outside space for warm-up. However, you will still need to report to the holding area at your designated report time.

AWARDS CEREMONY/RETREAT: There will be one retreat for percussion and two retreats for color guard. Please check the schedule for times.

VIDEO TAPING: There will be one video pass per unit included in your check-in packet. No other video taping will be allowed.

GUARD GRAMS: We will have diamond guard grams available for a cost of \$2.00 each. The announcer will use discretion when reading all diamond grams. Inappropriate messages will not be read and no refund will be provided.

FLOWERS: A variety of flowers will be available for sale. These may be purchased at a table located in the lobby of the gymnasium by the spectator's entrance

PROGRAMS: Programs will be available throughout the day in the ticket booth for a cost of \$ 3.00

CONSESSION STAND: Our concession stands will be open from 11:00 AM until 9:00 PM. We have enclosed a menu for your convenience.

HOSPITALITY ROOMS: There will be separate hospitality room for the directors, please stop and enjoy the food and drinks.
