

## Concert Band Music Performance Assessment 3/5&6/10

- Who:** Members of Wind and Percussion classes (Period 2, 3, 4 &7)
- When:** 7<sup>th</sup> period will meet right after lunch on Friday (during 5<sup>th</sup> period) to warm up and perform. They should be finished with sight-reading by 3:00pm.  
4<sup>th</sup> period will report to the band room at 9am or as soon as possible after the race traffic clears.  
**2<sup>nd</sup> period will report in uniform to the cafeteria at 1:30 (THIS IS A CHANGE).**
- Where:** Lyman High School
- Cost:** No admission is charged for concert band festival. (Spectators are also encouraged to follow the band to sight-reading.)
- Attire:** Concert Band uniform is required. White dress/tux shirt, black pants (Not black jeans), black tie and cummerbund (provided and passed out during warm-up), black dress shoes **and BLACK socks for guys.**
- Pick-Up:** As per FBA rules, students may be excused only at the conclusion of sight-reading. However while on campus, both before and after our performance, students need to keep their uniform on (shirts tucked in) and represent Lyman with appropriate behavior. (Please keep in mind that EVERYONE that performs on stage is required to sight-read with the band immediately following our performance. This is an FBA rule, not a Lyman rule. Disqualification of the entire band could result.)
