



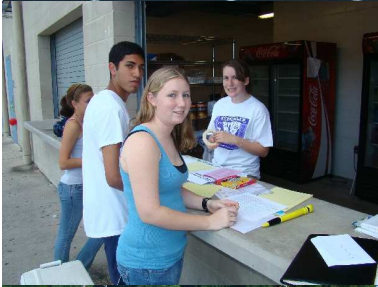
THE LYMAN MARCHING GREYHOUNDS THANK YOU!
