 8. New business – Most of these items were to see what direction our membership is interested in pursuing.
 - a. Bylaws revisions.
 - i. Membership – Service hours clarification/adjustment, GPA, Dues, Attendance requirement (Meetings and Inductions)
 - Service hours will be 10 hours in total for the school year.
 - Everyone will be required to do a Solo/Ensemble performance.
 - -If they can't make the performance, All-State/All-County Auditions as well as Recitals may be allowed to cover your performance credit.
 - The required GPA will be 3.5 weighted.
 - Everyone will be required to pay \$25 dues.
 - On the first Wednesday of every month there will be a meeting.
 - If members miss 3 meetings with unexcused absences, their membership may be terminated.
 - i. Induction – band concert/stand-alone event?
 - We raises awareness if the inductions are before/during/after band concerts, but also loses it's credibility/specialness as a separate organization..... we will discuss this further another time.
 - a. Service projects
 - i. MPA volunteers/All-State
 - All-State and MPA - People will help direct students around the campus or the parking lot.
 - i. Mentorship at Milwee and RL (See Below)
 - Milwee - Yes, there will be mentorships for everyone to attend.
 - Rock Lake - Yes, people living in or near the neighborhood will be able to help.
 - i. Concerts both MS and Lyman
 - Helping at the chorus concerts will help with recruiting.
 - i. Caroling/Salvation Army/nursing home
 - Caroling with instruments at nursing homes for holiday and non-holiday-related events.
 - a. Possible fundraising goals/fundraisers
 - This money will be put towards elementary school teacher's convention fees.
 - i. Top golf
 - This will allow for a \$10 ticket to be sold as \$20 for a \$10 profit. The \$10 profit from each ticket will be put toward the convention fees for elementary school teachers.
 - i. Flowers at concerts/dance shows
 - Flowers being sold at concerts/dance shows will help as parents/relatives/significant others will want to buy flowers for someone in band or in dance.
 - a. Meeting Dates/Times
 - First Wednesday of every month after school.

 - The shirt will possibly be put into the colors of Blue and Gold to represent Lyman's colors, but as of right now, it will stay as the purple shirt.
